### General

- January minutes –unanimously approved.

### Financials/Cherries

- Lani still has cherries left to distribute. If all are sold will be almost \$12,000 profit to district. Feedback on cherries – some like dark chocolate better; some like the milk chocolate. There is a dark chocolate option from vendor. Barb will get some samples to try and make a decision of what we are going to do next fall.
- Registration is way down – looking at approximately 110 athletes but budgeted for 135 so will be very tight and will need to really watch expenses.
- Financial Report was passed.

### Arena Dirt

- Still don't have a definite answer on what we are going to do to get the dirt out of the arena after the meet; Candi working on someone to donate the removal.

### Cows/Schedule

- We have found roping/daubing cows available at \$20/head; we budgeted \$15/head but with estimates on numbers of athletes, we determined we can do \$20/head and stay within budget.
- Cows are not trained so will need time through chute before competition.
- Will move Driving to Friday morning after meeting, before Saddle Seat (Lani to confirm with judges) and Working Rancher to Sagebrush first thing Saturday morning (set-up Friday night) to accommodate roping/daubing cows in Juniper.
- Need horse for Roping & Daubing judge. Trisha from Mt. View will bring horse for judge.

### District Meet

- Shavings – Brightenwood has said they will provide; Madras to coordinate; Marty to check current shaving supply.
- Cannot arrive at meet until Thursday at 3pm with campers or trailers. Fairgrounds needs to be able to have full access to grass area to lay out electrical a-frames so we cannot allow early dropping of campers.
- Judges Room – made a few changes to last year's list; trying to eliminate waste; last year muffins didn't get eaten because judges have breakfast before they arrive; will have veggie and fruit trays in the fridge for the weekend but will primarily just have drinks, lunch and dinner provided; have meet #1 covered but still some open slots for meet #2 & #3; list attached.
- 4-wheelers – we have secured one for dragging gaming events on Sunday (Richardson/Redmond); need a 2<sup>nd</sup>; Yvette has parent she can check with and Bend will check with Al Campbell; **please coordinate with Marty if we have secured a second one.**
- Music for Team Penning – Barb will create ultra clean playlist so we can have music during team penning.

- Stewardship – decided we need a list so team is aware of whether they need an adult or youth rep if there is a stewardship issue; this will help with chaos; list attached and will be in office.

**Other**

- Brightenwood donated 15 barrels to OHSET (metal/large) if anyone needs some (contact Amber White).
- Update on Absolute Horse Sponsorship (some info from after meeting) – Absolute Horse will speak to our athletes during the Saturday morning meeting re: helmet safety; they will provide a handout which we will distribute through team folders at the meet; handouts will have card on them to return for helmet drawing (2 helmets raffled during penning); they will also provide some athlete prizes.
