General

- December minutes – change date on top to December 10, 2014 - unanimously approved.

Financials

- 152 bags of cherries left to distribute. If all are sold will be almost \$12,000 profit to district.
- Registration is way down – looking at approximately 110 athletes but budgeted for 135 so will be very tight and will need to really watch expenses.

Rule Books

- Karissa Dishon will be bringing to Redmond on Friday and Barb will arrange to pick up and distribute.

Raffle Tickets

- There will be incentives for raffle ticket selling this year.
- Top seller in each district will receive \$100 cash card.
- Top seller in state will receive \$200 cash card.

District Meet

- Schedule – Motion (Tahnee/Yvette) – alternate between arenas for gaming events. Discussion – Fair. Allows all gaming events to be in both arenas at least once. The dirt is very different in each arena. Also would prepare us for all events at state as the gaming and performance events alternate (by year) between inside and outside. 8- yes; 1-no; 1 – abstain. Motion passes.
- Discussed why we have the gaming events set up the way we have them and a lot of it has to do with minimizing working the arena. Discussed putting Individual Flags before Keyhole because of the chalk used in Keyhole but decided to leave.
- Would like to have cars and trailers back off the east side of Sagebrush. Motion (Tahnee/Galyn) – put row of cones back 10 feet from side and cars and trailers will park behind. Passed unanimously.
- Cows – still looking for roping/daubing and working rancher cows. Need approximately 44 head. Yvette to check with Kurt Pillman to see if he can provide or knows where we can get them.
- Need calm, easy horse for roping/daubing judge.
- Team Penning – need to get settlers, numbers and glue.
- Stalls, Camping and Events due February 11 for first meet (March 18th for second and April 8th for third). \$35 stalls for weekend and \$25 per night camping.
- Banners for team penning – Motion (Cindi/Julie) – we allow each school 1 sponsor banner in the team penning arena (along cow pen area). Passed unanimously.
- Worked through schedule – see attached.
- Need 4-Wheelers – Redmond checking and Barb will check with Dufur; Drags – Crook and 4-H drag.

Other

- We are working with Absolute Horse on a district sponsorship. They would provide products for drawings or district use. Work in progress...
