

Central District OHSET Meeting Minutes – February 28, 2018

Nancy moved to accept the January 31st district meeting minutes, Jenelle 2nd. Passed unanimously.

Financials

- Continue to turn in money as we go along.
 - **All money for cherries and raffle tickets must be turned in by 3rd meet.**
 - If you didn't sell all your raffle tickets, you must turn the stubs back in by 3rd meet – all tickets must be accounted for!
- Camping and stall money for 2nd meet due tonight!
 - \$40/stall for the weekend and camping \$30/night.
 - You will receive 2 bags of shavings at Rim Rock.
 - Additional shavings \$10/bag, will be purchased directly from Rim Rock and you cannot bring in your own shavings.
- Budget passed out – looking good.
 - Please make sure your district sponsorship (\$30/athlete) money is paid by 3rd meet.
 - Let your district chairs know if we need to recognize sponsors.

Combine Team

- Crook and Pendleton would like to combine for team events. Paperwork turned in to district.
 - Crook has 5 athletes, Pendleton 3.
 - Nancy moved we accept the combine team of Crook and Pendleton. Jenelle 2nd. Motion passed unanimously.

Horse Expo

- We will have an OHSET booth at the High Desert Horse Expo, April 21-22.
 - Look for online sign-up – we want our athletes in the booth promoting OHSET.

Meet 1

- General consensus – went very smooth, little rushing with current schedule.
- There was a miscommunication on roping/daubing – never announced that we would be starting, but athletes appeared to see it being set up and rushed out, but we were running slightly behind the “scheduled” start (all times are estimates).
- We will look for faster drag on Sunday.
 - Been discussed we might use rakes
 - The Dalles has offered a faster drag for meet 3
 - At meet 2 we will use Rim Rock equipment
 - We have also moved Keyhole to the end of the schedule to save the time it takes to drag the chalk lines out
- Can we do something about clunky, deep dirt in Sagebrush?
 - Better after drag but still felt it was unsafe for reining
 - Barb will discuss with fairgrounds staff and see what we can do
- Drill – arena drag started and Redmond did not get warm-up time
 - This was miscommunication with drag volunteer – meant for Event Center only to get drag and he must have thought he was also dragging Sagebrush. Will make sure doesn't happen again.
 - If you don't get appropriate warm-up for any event – let one of your chairs know!

- Can always reach them by gate radio if not in sight.
- Get your judge evaluations and sportsmanship votes in
 - The judge evaluations are addressed as we go along – they don't do our state judge's chair much good after the season is over!
- Thank you everyone for your awareness of safety – very few issues!
- Thank you notes list e-mailed – please make sure you send team thank you
 - We also have an additional list we will be sending thank you notes out from the district

Meet 2

- Schedule a little different for meet 2 (attached)
 - We will be doing some of our events in the "Brasada arena"
 - Note – we do not have this arena on Sunday – please help keep athletes out
 - Roping and daubing are inside at Rim Rock
 - Gaming should not go as long as scheduled – Lani only has meet 1 to go by and we are going to make sure the events run quicker with dragging and changes made, so make sure you are ready for earlier start times.
- Get your camping and stall fees and numbers in – they are due tonight
 - Camping will be assigned and you will have electric and water
 - Stalls – we will avoid the outside stalls due to wind
- National anthem
 - Great addition to our morning!
 - Have a second singer for meet 2
- Event volunteers – everyone good?
 - Will have slight change because Sisters was on 3 gaming events and that made for hard day – teams effected will be notified of any changes
- Need additional gate person for gaming at meet 2 – will keep athletes on side until needed to be ready at gate
- Movie night at meet 2 Friday night after drill – more info at the meet
- Passed out parking map for Rim Rock
 - Please make sure families know that we want to keep all car parking in front of the main arena on the road side, or in the camping area (as long as not blocking fire lane)

Meet 3

- Will leave south entrance closed and bring Showmanship and In Hand Trail in same gate
 - Teams running these events will need extra gate person
 - Also once Showmanship is done will have room for trail warm inside
- Gaming will be in 2 arenas to make time for awards.

Awards

- Need to return trophies directly to Best Buy
 - If you are out of the area, bring them to meet 2 and we will get them there
- Oregon Feed will be sponsoring reserve champion and 3rd place awards in all high point categories
- State qualifier t-shirts will be sponsored by Coyote Rock Ranch
 - Athlete reps picked teal for this year's color
- We will do certificates again this year as well

Other Business

 - She was at the meet most of the weekend, but could only cover one arena at a time
