

JUDGING CRITERIA FOR OHSET SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS 2010

The following criteria will be followed.

- A. OHSET Participation – 40 points**
 - 1. Years in OHSET.
 - 2. Individual and team events entered.
 - 3. Leadership roles; team captain, drill captain, team representative, district representative, etc.
 - 4. Accomplishments: Medals won at District and/or state, team awards, records, events qualified for State Championship in.
(Participation on an individual and Team basis)

- B. Membership and participation in non OHSET equestrian activities. List and describe accomplishments. – 20 points**

- C. Please tell about other school and leadership activities. – 20 points**

- D. Community Service – 20 points**
 - 1. Years in service and what activity.
 - 2. Role in each activity.

- E. Educational Goals – 20 points**
 - 1. Preparation
 - 2. Follow through

- F. Describe how OHSET has influenced your life – 20 points**

- G. Conflict in OHSET – 20 points**
 - 1. Briefly describe the conflict, how you handled it, and what you learned from it.

- H. Tell us briefly why you should be chosen to receive a scholarship. – 20 points**

- I. Include 2 letters of recommendation. – 10 points each**

The scholarship committee will be looking at:

Content, Clarity, Motivation, Dedication, and Commitment to OHSET and your Team. Grade transcripts/Home School equivalent will be used as the tie breaker only.
