



Coaches and Advisor Training Requirements

Below are the required training for all coaches and advisors:

1. All registered head coaches and advisors **MUST** take the OSAA certification training once in their career. This must be complete before the team is registered or any practices.
2. All registered coaches (this includes assistants, drill, etc.) **MUST** attend the OHSET Coaches and Advisors training (in person) once every two (2) years. This means if you did not attend last season you must attend before the season starts. This training will be offered twice a year. Please see the OHSET state website calendar for information on when and where training is scheduled.
3. Your team may not register or practice without the completion of both trainings.
4. In case you are thinking of becoming a “clinician” instead of a “coach”, remember a couple of things:
 - a. There is no liability or medical insurance provided contractors.
 - b. There must be a registered coach at all team practices.
 - c. Clinicians make **NO** decisions about varsity vs junior varsity.
 - d. Clinicians have no standing at a meet.
 - e. If you are working with athletes more than a few times, you are a coach and training is required.
