

Hunt Seat Equitation Over Fences-Equipment List 2010

Fence #1 & #4-Post and Rail

- 2'3"-2'5" in Height
- 2 Standards
- 5 Rails (1 across top, 2 crossed below, 2 ground lines)
- 4 Cups

Fence #2- Post and Rail

- 2'6"-2'8" in Height
- 2 Standards
- 4 rails (1 across top, 2 crossed below, 1 ground line)
- 4 Cups

Fence #3 & #8- Brush

- 2'6"-2'8" in Height
- 2 standards
- 3 rails (1 across top, 2 groundlines)
- Brush to reach bottom of top rail from standard to standard
- 2 Cups

Fence#5a & 5b-Panel

- Fence A should be 2'3"-2'5" and Fence B should be 2'5"-2'8". Fence B should be minimum of 2" taller than A.
- 2 Standards (each)
- 2 panels to reach from standard to standard
- 2-4 rails (needs ground line on each fence, may or may not need top rail)
- 2-4 Cups (each)

Fence #6-Post and Rail

- 2'5"-2'7" in Height
- 2 Standards
- 4 rails (1 across top, 2 crossed below, 1 ground line)
- 4 Cups

Jump #7- ¼ Round

- ¼ Round
- 2 Standards
- Optional: Top Rail
 - 2 Cups needed if used

All Fences should be 10-12 feet wide, unless otherwise specified
